CHANGES TO VOTING RULES

Don't lose your right to vote! From 4th May you will need to show photo ID when voting in person in most UK elections or referenda. This can be a UK passport, driving licence, blue badge, bus pass, etc. If you do not have photo ID, you can apply for a 'voter authority certificate' free of charge. Visit www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate to find out more.
