## COXWOLD VILLAGE HALL

## COXWOLD PARISH COUNCIL

Further to the traffic survey in August 2020, the Parish Council has secured funding to establish a footpath from the end of the railway line to connect with the pavement on Hushwaite Road and reduce pedestrian exposure to traffic. We already have the full support of the NYMNPA and Newburgh Priory to secure a “permissive footpath” agreement.

We are now calling for volunteers to help clear the scrub so that we can lay gravel along the footway. This needs to be done as soon as possible, once the route has been marked, before the bird-nesting season starts in March. We will be updating everyone via the Nextdoor App. If you are able to help prune back and clear the path, please respect COVID19 protocols and keep a suitable distance from other volunteers.
