Marathon Fundraiser!

On 22nd March, we will be running the 2019 Palestine Marathon to raise funds for Action around Bethlehem Children with Disability (ABCD). The money will be used to equip and run a new rehabilitation centre for physically, mentally or multi-handicapped children and young persons in the Aroub refugee camp in the West Bank, Palestine. We discovered the centre for rehabilitation of disabled kids in a run-down building. It has no equipment to speak of and desperately needs our help. Reduced UN funding and limited access to medical facilities outside the camp make our task more urgent – also, I am not sure how many more half marathons we can manage: it's not flat in Bethlehem! With your help we can do it – please can you help us even if it's a little as lots of littles make one big push to provide the initial; we need £5,000, hopefully match funded by others, to begin the task.

Please think of or pray for us as we trundle around the sacred spires and daunting watch towers of Bethlehem for this incredible charity. We are really grateful for any help you can give us. Thank you!
