COXWOLD EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE WHATSAPP GROUP

During the recent defibrillator training session, there was a discussion about how to handle an emergency if you're on your own and/or need urgent assistance from neighbours. The trainer mentioned that other communities had set up WhatsApp groups for this purpose.

If you have WhatsApp skills and would be willing to be the group administrator, please also mention this, as current WhatsApp skills are very limited.

The group rules are very simple: 1) Only use it for genuine emergencies where you need someone to come to your home immediately. 2) Keep messages brief, but if possible descriptive, just the word 'Help' if nothing else comes to mind. 3) If you receive a message and are able, drop everything and go to your neighbour's address – it's better to have lots of people turn up than none!

North Yorkshire Police advise that any dead birds should be reported to North Yorkshire Council on 0300 131 2131 to arrange safe collection. Contact the RSPCA on 0200 1234 999 if you find a sick or injured bird. Do not handle sick or dead birds. Do not disturb wild birds and do not approach large flocks. Keep dogs on leads.
