Generally known for being the former home of 18th century writer Laurence Sterne, Shandy Hall has been a lived-in house for 600 years, and traces of its history and evidence of former residents are still emerging.

EXCELLENT BIRD IDENTIFIER APP

Merlin Bird ID from Cornell University can identify birds from song recorded on a smartphone. It produces a real-time list of species with images. You can then compare them with other confirmed recordings and get tips on how to identify them. Download the app from Apple App Store or Google Play.
