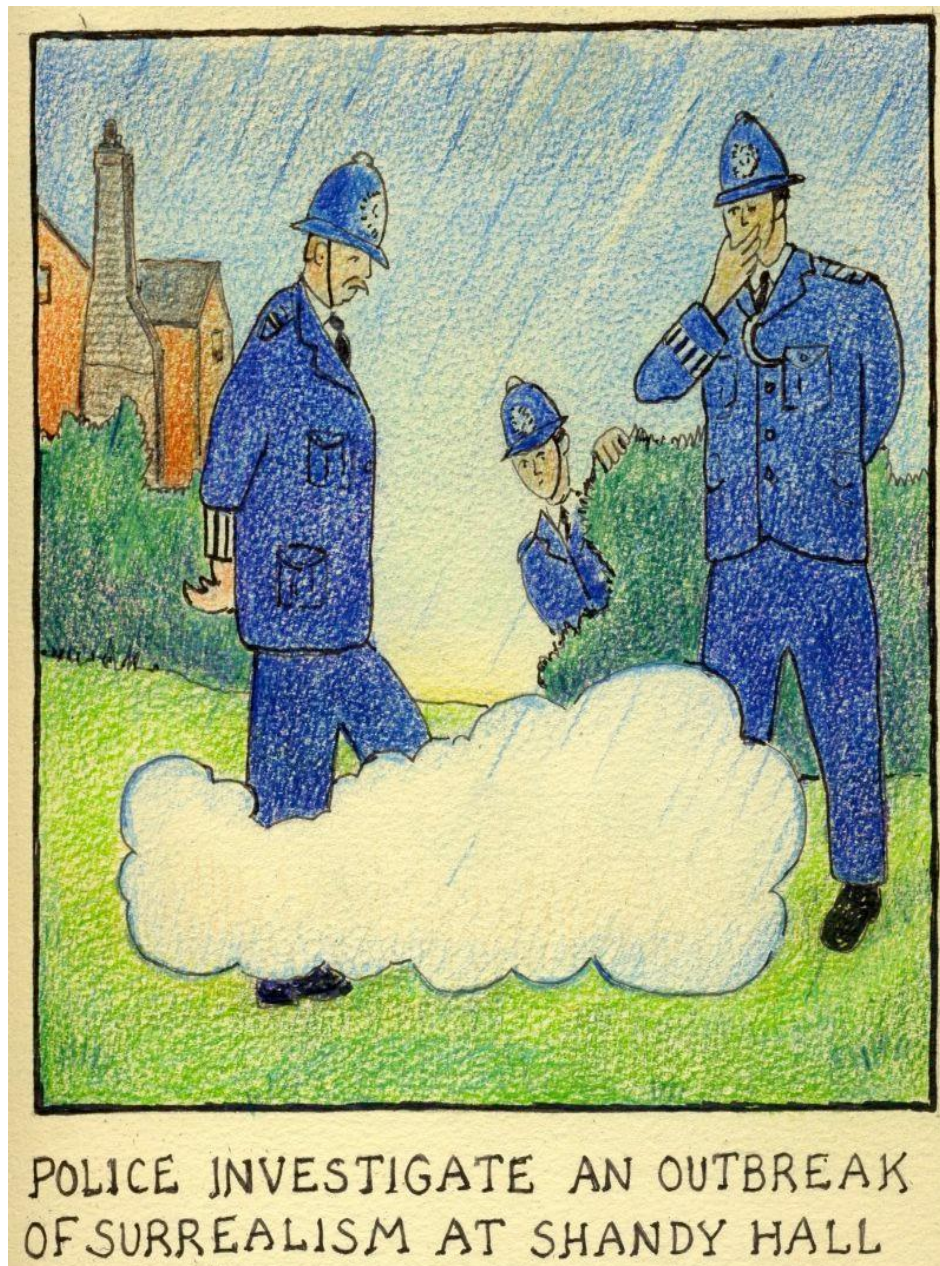

REPORT A POTHOLE

Any road condition issue (obstruction, spillage or damage) that is causing an immediate danger to the safety of road users is classed as an emergency and should be reported to North Yorkshire Council on 0300 131 2131 (Monday and Tuesday 9.00am to 5.00pm; Wednesday 9.30am to 5.00pm; Thursday 9.00am to 5.00pm and Friday 9.00am to 4.30pm). Out of office hours, call North Yorkshire Police on 101. If there is danger to life, call 999. Other non-emergency potholes can be reported online at: [https:// myaccount.northyorks.gov.uk/pothole](https://myaccount.northyorks.gov.uk/pothole). Please note that motorways and trunk roads, such as the A19 (north of Thirsk), A66 and A64, are not the responsibility of the council. For these roads, you should report issues to Highways England on info@highwaysengland.co.uk or by phone on 0300 123 5000.
