a) Traffic management	<p>Throughout the year the P.C has had regular meetings with NYCC and the police in the village to try to improve the management of traffic passing through it. There have been improvements including renewal of cobbled gullies in Main Street, resurfacing, new road markings, bollards to protect the Forge and the presence on several occasions of a traffic police motorcyclist.</p> <p>The speed gun initiative will be repeated later in the summer and volunteers will be sought. There have been two accidents at the crossroads and Cllr. Patmore notified the Police Commissioner.</p> <p>No registration numbers have ever been submitted to the police by the Parish Council. In answer to a question regarding the wearing of high viz jackets by volunteers the Chairperson advised that in the past a low profile had been practised by the speed gun volunteers in order to comply with police advice. Unless there were police objections to volunteers wearing high viz jackets this would be considered in the future. The Parish Council would like to see the establishment of flashing speed signs at all four entrances to the village.</p>	J. Rob
