ii) Traffic calming	<p>NYCC is meeting on 26th March to sign off the agreed protocol for Vehicle Activated signs. The possibility of sharing a VAS with a neighbouring parish was discussed. Following discussion with Paul Grimwood and John Hunter it was felt that in addition to VAS there may need to be more speed gun presence and that the possibility of a chicane at the top end of the village should be explored.</p> <p>Following discussion at the last NYMNPA Parish Forum MP Kevin Hollingrake has been invited to attend the forthcoming meeting on the 9th April at NYMNPA headquarters in Helmsley. Three questions for him have been requested regarding traffic issues.
